## 2022 Enrolments and Classes

We are beginning the process of looking at class structures for 2022. Schools need to be very specific with numbers as it not only determines the number of classes but the learning programs that can be

offered.

If you have a child who is due to start reception in 2022 please contact the front office to confirm that an enrolment form has been completed. Or if you are planning to enrol your child at another site next year, please let the Front Office know as soon as possible.

## **Attendance**

A child of compulsory school age must attend at the school in which they are enrolled on every day, and for such parts of every day, that instruction is provided for the child at the school.

Whilst there is normally a spike in absences once winter has settled in, we have seen a bigger than normal increase in absence. It is vitally important that the school has Research shows that absence from school correct personal information for your child, has a significant impact on students:-

• The maximum penalties for a parent or program, or fails to take reasonable keeping safe near roads. steps to make sure their child attends school or participates in an approved

learning program, has increased from \$500 to \$5,000.

• Principals of government and nongovernment schools having to notify the Chief Executive if a child is failing to attend school or participate in an approved learning program, without reasonable excuse, for 10 or more days in a school term.

If you are having difficulty getting your child to school, please contact the Front Office to make a time with leadership to discuss an Attendance Plan.

Please DO NOT use School Road (Permit Parking) to drop off or pick up your child/ children. You will be fined if caught by the council and it is also for the safety of our students that parents/caregivers DO NOT drive down School Road.
