2022 Enrolments and Classes

As has been mentioned previously, we have begun the process of looking at class structures for 2022. If you are aware of any families who are planning to enrol at Gawler Primary School next year, or you are planning to enrol your child/ren elsewhere in 2022, please contact the Front Office as soon as possible. If you have a child who is due to start reception in 2022 please contact the front office to confirm that an enrolment form has been completed.

Arrival of Students on site before 8.30am

Recently we have had a number of students arriving on school grounds well before 8.30am. I would like to remind all families that **no staff will be on yard duty until 8.30am**. If you require before school care, this can be arranged with OSHC which operates from 6.30am - 8.30am Monday - Friday.

Student Safety on roads

We have had concerns raised by parents and members of the public over the number of children who cross Nixon Terrace without looking for traffic that may be coming. Could you please discuss with your child/ren the importance of stopping at the kerb, looking and listening for traffic and only crossing when safe. Yard duty staff have also had to remind students not to be riding bikes/scooters through gate entrances, which causes a safety hazard.

It is vitally important that the school has correct personal information for your child, especially with the uncertainty around the ever changing situation with COVID-19.

PAT-R and PAT-M testing/NAPLAN results

Please note that before the end of term all students in years 3-7 will undertake testing in reading and maths, this is very similar to NAPLAN but a shorter test that gives our school/teachers information about how students are going in these areas. This information is not distributed to families and is used to inform teaching points.

NAPLAN results will arrive in schools within the next week or two and you will receive your child/rens results by the end of term 3.

If you have a son at Gawler Primary School you may have heard that the boys toilets were upgraded during the term 2 break. The boys have certainly expressed how much nicer the toilets are after the renovations.
