From the Principal

Term 3

Wishing all students and families a safe and enjoyable holiday break and we look forward to seeing everyone back to what is shaping up to be a jam packed term 4!

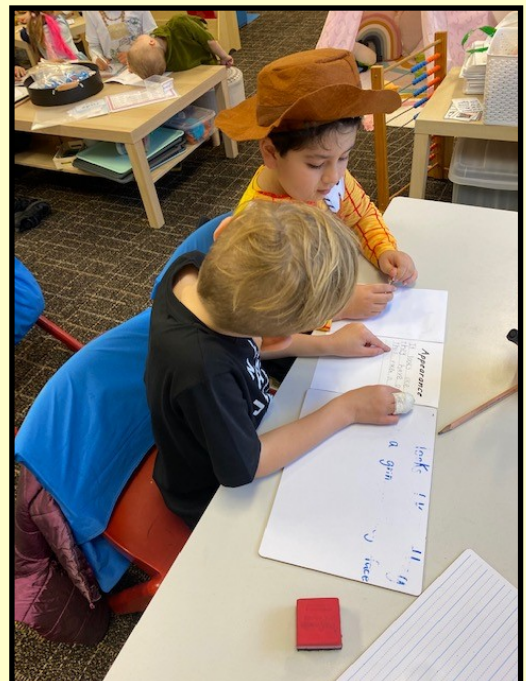
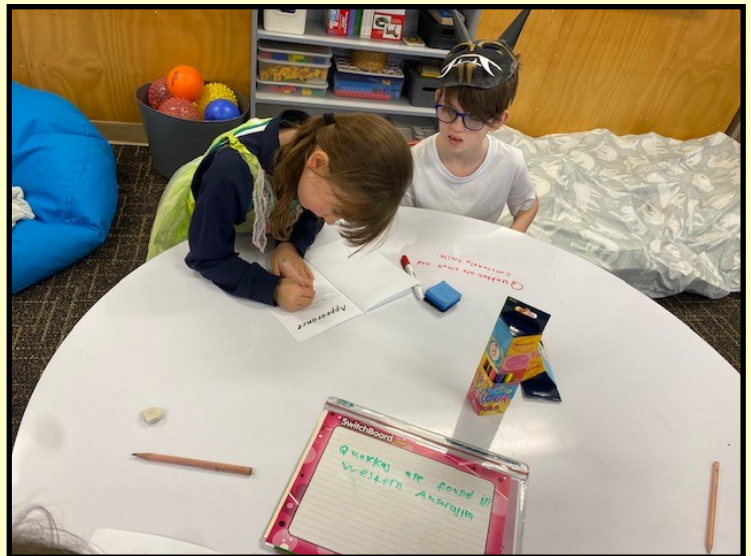
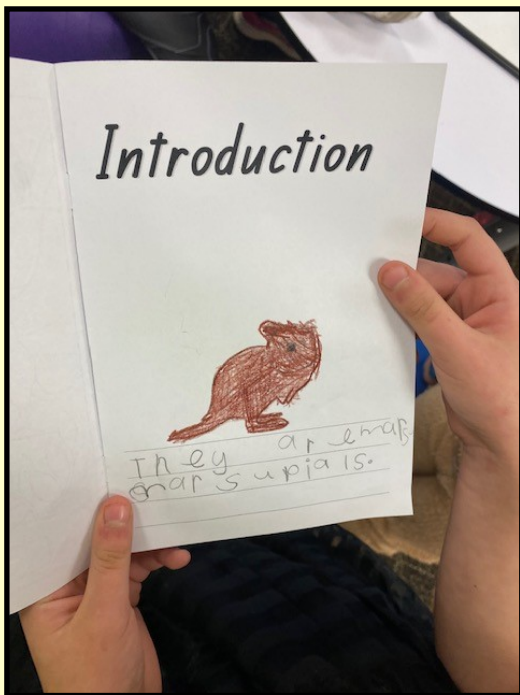
